I am pleased to invite your child on a school trip as part of their Year 10 French studies. We have managed to secure a screening of the French film 'Belle and Sebastian 2' (English subtitles) at the Odeon Cinema in Hull City Centre on **Monday 31 March 2025**. This is an exciting opportunity to hear French being spoken and put their learning into practice.

We will depart the school at 9:30am and anticipate arriving back at school around 12:00-12.30pm, traffic depending. Students will return to lessons for the afternoon session as usual and will be back in school in time for some of their lunch break, if not all.

The cost of the visit is **£21.12** per student and this will cover travel, cinema entry, insurance and a food package including popcorn, sweets and a drink. Pre orders will be taken once places are allocated. Please note the trip is an 'optional extra' under the 1996 Education Act" and the school is therefore permitted to charge for this activity.
